Key

In a *history week*, the support element of the curriculum is based on relevant historical accounts, e.g. the meaning of the 28th October celebrations throughout wks 2-7 etc

In a *geography week*, the support element of the curriculum is based on knowing areas of Greece and Cyprus, e.g. get to know Thessaloniki, Nicosia: the last divided city of Europe, Mount Athos, Acropolis and its new museum etc

In a *religious week*, the support element of the curriculum is based on religious history, e.g. the meaning of Christmas, who were the Three Hierarchs etc
